I would like to strongly object to the proposal to build on the Land Behind the Moors at Kidlington. 1. It is farmland and should remain as farmland. Crops are grown there every year. 2. The fields flood during the winter months 3. The access road proposed would render Benmead Road a major through road to the Banbury Rd. Currently this road has a pinch point where cars are parked out side North Kidlington Primary School. Parents and children are there at different times of the day. It is often difficult to pass through often. 4. There are several other developments planned in Kidlington and this one is a step too far. The traffic is already very heavy in the village. 5.
