We object to the outline planning application for up to 340 houses on Part OS Parcel 0006 North of The Moors Kidlington.

Firstly the land is designated Greenbelt and there is no justification for allowing development on the Greenbelt. We should protect this important breathing space and we object to the loss of this vital amenity where many of us exercise ourselves and walk our dogs.

We moved to Meadow View off The Moors in 1978 and now live in Briar Close off The Moors and there have been numerous occasions when local gardens and fields have flooded. Erecting 340 house and a cricket pavilion will surely make the flooding worse.

Those who live in The Moors know that it is used by many vehicles to bypass Oxford Road and Banbury Road and as a result it is difficult and often dangerous to exit from the north end of The Moors onto Banbury Road, particularly first thing in the morning and last thing in the afternoon especially with the unclear turn into the Coop shop opposite the end of The Moors. How much more dangerous will this be if the proposed 340 houses and cricket pavilion are allowed to be built and bring additional vehicles onto The Moors ?

There are already excellent cricket pitches at Stratfield Brake and we object to the traffic and noise that would be generated from this unnecessary additional facility.

At present vehicles are often parked in the vicinity of Homewood House (which is only 200 metres from the proposed southern exit from the development) and cause frequent traffic hold ups which would inevitably increase with the vehicles from the proposed development.

To summarise we object to the proposed application and hope that you refuse on our behalf.
