I would like to object to the proposed plan for an extensive housing development on the land behind The Moors. This is an important area of green belt land which I use almost daily to walk my dog, allowing me to exercise in open countryside and maintain good mental health. Although there are a number of other fields towards the river and behind St Mary's, these fields are under water for extended periods of time over the winter months, making the fields behind The Moors all the more precious. Building on this land would increase the level of flooding in the remaining fields and onto the existing roads around the area.

These fields are also important for the abundant wildlife, which is also pushed up onto this land when the lower fields are flooded. We already have deer, foxes and badgers being pushed up into the village and this plan would further reduce their habitat. This proposed build would significantly increase the level of traffic on The Moors and the surrounding streets, reducing the flow of traffic.

I have no interest in cricket (or football) and know that there is already existing provision for cricket pitches elsewhere in the village. Like many women and girls, my main form of exercise and relaxation is walking in green spaces and a development which removes this opportunity in favour of more male-oriented sports provision is discriminatory. With so many new house builds already planned for Kidlington it would be very wrong to go ahead with this project. I hope you will give consideration to my concerns and reject this proposal.
