To whom it may concern,

I am writing to you to share my concerns on the planning application North Of The Moors Kidlington (25/01346/OUT) and to OBJECT to these plans.

My boyfriend and I bought our house on the Moors almost a year ago, with a key attraction to this property being its quiet, peaceful road and close proximity to the Kidlington countryside. I am very concerned that this planning application will severely disrupt the road, causing significantly more traffic and noise, as well as making the road less safe for children.

As someone who commutes from Kidlington into Oxford (I work at the JR), I am very aware of how bad the traffic is at commuting times to get out of Kidlington. It has regularly taken me over an hour to get from the Moors to Parkway at peak commuting times. If these houses are to be built, this will only be much worse, and this must be considered before any further houses are built. Further to this, the public transport infrastructure from the Moors must be improved if more houses are to be built. I regularly get the S4 or S7 to Parkway, before then catching the 700 from Parkway to the JR. All of these buses are often full at peak times. More often than not, there is standing room only on the S4 or S7 that stop at the Moors Turning stop, and I have been on the 700 bus where they have had to turn people away.

For these reasons, we object to the planning application.
