Please find attached a broad description of the landscape types, local character areas and strategic guidelines generally associated for your area of search. They are taken from the Oxfordshire Wildlife and Landscape Study (OWLS). They do not provide a detailed overview of your specific area and it will be necessary for you to undertake a more detailed assessment of the landscape features to determine their exact status and condition within the broad landscape types.

According to my records there are no designated wildlife sites or habitats within the area but it will be necessary for you to contact the Thames Valley Environmental Records Centre (Gavin Bird (Gavin.Bird@Oxfordshire.gov.uk) for more detailed information particularly in relation to protected species.
