COLLEGE FIELDS Banbury

Thank you for your letter dated 24th November and received on the 25th.

We have carried out an initial search and can confirm that there are no registered parks or gardens or battlefields in the vicinity of the site. There is one Scheduled Ancient monument (ref OX172) Tooleys Boatyard in the area but at some distance from the site.

Information on archaeological finds and significance can be obtained from the Sites and Monuments Record, held by the county Archaeological unit and the location of any listed buildings in the vicinity should be available from the local authority.

My only comments on the proposed list of topics for the EIA are that assessment of impact on the landscape should include consideration of the historic landscape and not just visual impact. The potential impact on settings of listed buildings or conservation area should also be considered in the scoping and advice on the definition of the setting should be available from the local authority.
