 practice. For any such species found, action programmes for their
 retention/rescue/translocation should be included.
- The Environment Agency should be consulted over potential effects of the proposed development on its areas of responsibility.
- Potential sources of disturbance and/or pollution should be described, such as air emissions, site lighting, surface water runoff, and construction traffic. These can
