## Seed Mix:

## **Post Installation Maintenance**

No initial aftercare is required as the initial establishment has taken place at the supplier nursery ensuring a quality product at the time of installation.

One visit is recommended early Autumn period to hand weed and remove any airborne weed seedlings. This is followed by a light strim to approximately 75-100mm and remove all arising's. The wild flower seeds will shed in this process and provide seed for re-germination the following season whilst also proving a resource for nature over Winter.

During the dormant season of the wildflowers, the sedum will provide a ground cover and a Winter feature.

The above should be carried out each year
