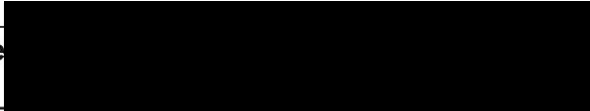
- a) offers no comment on the addendum to the Environmental Statement which has been received in connection with the above application.
