- where your completed questionnaire, yours and the appellant's statements and future comments can be inspected;
- that they may attend the hearing and, at the Inspector's discretion, give their views;
- that the decision will be published on the Planning Portal;
- what facilities are available for people with disabilities e.g. parking spaces, access and seating arrangements etc.

## You should send a copy of this letter and a list of those notified to the case officer.

If you consider it appropriate, please notify the press of the hearing and, if notice of the hearing is published in the press, send a copy of the notice(s) to the case officer. Please also note that people with disabilities who may be concerned about facilities at the hearing venue have been advised to write to, or contact, you to confirm that proper provisions are in place.

Typically, decisions are issued within 7 weeks of the close of the hearing, although we cannot be precise about individual cases.
