
Amenity Shrub Species Selection

The selection of shrub species has drawn upon a combination of amenity shrub planting which is easy to maintain coupled with some key areas of interest around where residents would pause or rest. These species would provide seasonal leaf colour, rich textures and seasonal flowering to enhance the pedestrian experience along Camp Road.


Paving Materials Selection
