This application seeks to discharge condition 12 of TWA /10/APP/01 as it relates to the provision of a Flood Risk Assessment (FRA Level 3) for the Bicester Chord (AP1). This FRA follows the methodology set out in the Flood Storage and Compensation Technical note, dated July 2010, agreed with the Environment Agency. The application also seeks to discharge condition 13 as it relates to the provision of a Surface Water Drainage Assessment for the Bicester Chord. Section 5 of the FRA pertains to Surface Water Drainage Assessment for the Bicester Chord. This document also provides the information required by the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) and the associated requirements of PPS25, in considering the surface water drainage aspects of a Flood Risk Assessment for new development.
