Other Consents

An environmental permit or exemption may also be required for any proposed works or structures, in, under, over or within 8 metres of the top of the bank of designated 'main rivers'. Until recently this was called Flood Defence Consent. Some activities are also now <u>excluded</u> or <u>exempt</u>.
