Tree F - (Conifer 3) topping/crown reduction as restricting light and concern of tree height in relation to property. Tree G - (Conifer 4) crown reduction to allow more light into front bedroom. Tree H - (Conifer 5) topping/ crown reduction as restricting light and concern of tree height in relation to property.
