<u>Key issues</u>

- No details are supplied regarding parking provision for the village green in general and for cricket matches in particular.
- The development proposals are unlikely to have a significant adverse impact on the surrounding highway network.

Conditions

If the planning authority grants permission then the following condition should apply.

• D18 Plan of car parking permission.

Detailed Comments

The planning application does not include any details of proposed parking provision for the village green in general and for cricket matches in particular. The site location plan and the more detailed plan do show some spaces immediately to the north of the village green, although it is unclear whether any or all of these will be available to users of the village green. It is worth noting that the demand for parking during a cricket match could be significant with players, officials, spectators and caterers all likely to generate some demand. Details of parking proposals, together with some assessment of their adequacy, will be required.

The peak hour traffic generation associated with the village green is likely to be negligible. The development proposals are therefore unlikely to have a significant adverse impact on the surrounding highway network.
