- ANY DISCREPANCIES NOTED ON SITE ARE TO BE REPORTED TO THE ENGINEER IMMEDIATELY.
- THE BOTTOM OF ALL FOUNDATIONS ARE TO BE INSPECTED AND
- APPROVED BY BUILDING CONTROL BEFORE PLACING CONCRETE.
- ALL FOUNDATIONS ARE TO BE CENTRED ON THE CENTRE LINES OF WALLS UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE.
- O THE BASE SPECIFICATION FOR REINFORCED CONCRETE SHALL BE BS 8110 'STRUCTURAL USE OF CONCRETE' AND THE NATIONAL STRUCTURAL CONCRETE SPECIFICATION FOR BUILDING CONSTRUCTION.
- THE FOLLOWING CONCRETE MIXES ARE TO BE USED IN ACCORDANCE WITH BS 8500: PART 1, 2006, (ASSUMING THE SITE CLASSIFICATION AS IN NOTE No. 6 ABOVE) :-

MIX REFERENCE PLAIN CONC. FOUNDNS RC28/35

R.C. FOUNDNS BLINDING GEN1 CONCRETE INFILL RC20/25, 10mm AGG

- ALL CONCRETE MIX CERTIFICATES SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF WORK ON SITE. STANDARD CUBES SHALL BE TAKEN FOR COMPRESSIVE STRENGTH TESTING. ONE SET OF 3 CUBES SHALL BE TAKEN FOR EACH 20m3 OF CONCRETE PLACED, OR LESS PER DAY. ONE CUBE IS TO BE TESTED AT 7 DAYS, AND THE REMAINING 2 AT 28 DAYS.
- THE BASE SPECIFICATION FOR STRUCTURAL MASONRY SHALL BE BS5628 'CODE OF PRACTICE FOR USE OF MASONRY'. IN ADDITION, REFERENCE SHALL BE MADE TO THE ARCHITECTS MASONRY SPECIFICATION AND ASSOCIATED DRAWINGS.
- ALL BLOCKWORK IS TO HAVE A MINIMUM STRENGTH OF 10.4 N/mm². ALL BRICKWORK TO HAVE A MINIMUM STRENGTH OF 20N/mm², AND A MAXIMUM WATER ABSORPTION OF 12%. ALL DPC QUALITY BRICKWORK TO BE DPC1 OR DPC2 TO BS 3921.
- 5 ALL MASONRY TO BE LAID USING ORDINARY PORTLAND CEMENT:LIME:SAND MORTAR. ALL MORTAR TO BE $1:0-\frac{1}{4}:3$.
- APPROPRIATE CERTIFICATION, INCLUDING LABORATORY TEST RESULTS, MUST BE PROVIDED TO THE ENGINEER FOR ALL MASONRY UNITS AND PRE MIXED MORTAR PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF WORK ON SITE.
- FOR SITE BATCHED MORTAR, CUBES SHALL BE PREPARED AND CRUSHED AT INTERVALS AS OUTLINED IN THE SPECIFICATION. THE RESULTS OF SUCH TESTS SHALL BE COMPARED AGAINST TABLE 1 OF BS 5628 FOR ACCEPTANCE.

LOW-LEVEL DPC

- RETAINING WALL FROM TOP OF FOUNDATION TO 2 No. COURSES ABOVE GROUND LEVEL IS TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN DPC1 OR DPC2 QUALITY BRICKWORK.
- HIGH-LEVEL DPC
- 19 DPC & COPINGS TO ARCH.'S DETAILS.
- TO AVOID EXCESSIVE LOADS ON FRESH MORTAR, DO NOT EXCEED LIFTS OF 1.5m PER DAY.
- UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, THE MINIMUM EMBEDMENT OF WALL TIES SHALL BE 50mm.
- ALL WEEPHOLES TO BE 50mm DIAMETER @ 2.0m c/c, LOWER END 150mm ABOVE GROUND LEVEL. AFTER CONSTRUCTION, WEEPHOLES ARE TO BE KEPT CLEAR & FREE FROM OBSTRUCTIONS.

WATERPROOFING.

- PROVIDE 2 NO. COATS OF BITUMINOUS EMULSION TO THE RETAINED FACE OF WALLS. BOTH COATS TO EXTEND UP TO THE COPING. USE RIW 'LIQUID ASPHALTIC COMPOUND', OR SIMILAR. PROTECT WATERPROOFING WITH FIBRE BOARD, OR SIMILAR, BEFORE BACKFILLING.
- BACKFILLING
- 4 THE DRAINAGE LAYER, (BEHIND THE RETAINING WALL), SHOULD BE A FREE-DRAINING GRANULAR FILL, LIGHTLY COMPACTED, 450mm WIDE, THE DRAINAGE LAYER SHOULD BE SEPARATED FROM THE GENERAL BACKFILL BY A GEOTEXTILE FILTER FABRIC. USE TERRAM, OR SIMILAR.
- 25 ALLOW 28 DAYS FOR THE MORTAR TO SET BEFORE BACKFILLING.
- MOVEMENT JOINTS

FOUNDATION AT LOCATION OF HEATING PIPES

MOVEMENT JOINTS TO BE FULL HEIGHT, 16mm WIDE @ 10.0m c/c, AND WITHIN 6.0m OF A RETURN. TIE ACROSS THE JOINT WITH TIED SLEEVES AS NECESSARY. FILLER AND SEALANT TO ARCH.'S DETAILS.
