Further to your correspondence with Jack yesterday, as requested, Aspect Ecology has today carried out a nesting bird check of the hedgerow section at Longford Park that needs to be removed for the drainage trenches, as per the site plan you sent (copy below). The survey has confirmed there are no active bird nests present and the hedgerow section can therefore be removed as planned. Tom Kelly has been briefed on the results of today's survey.

This area of hedgerow should be removed as soon as possible and if it is not removed within three days then we may need to return to check for any potential new active nests.
