The planning conditions relating to operational noise comprise 19(1) to 19(14), require approval of Schemes of Assessment of the predicted noise and vibration impacts by the Local Planning Authority (LPA). In order to inform the LPAs' decisions, a report (or series of reports), prepared by an independent expert who has been previously approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority needs to be produced. Following the appointment of the separate IE's for Noise and Vibration by both Cherwell District Council (CDC) on the 7th May 2013 (CDC Ref: 13/00108/DISC) and Oxford City Council (OCC) on the 2nd May 2013 (OCC Ref: 13/00907/CND), it has become necessary to replace Brian Hemsworth as the Noise IE, as he is no longer available to carry out the current phase of work. The purpose of the attached application and scope is to formally appoint a replacement for the Noise independent expert.
