Hi Jennifer,

We would like to see T3, T6 and T10 cut down to hedge height. The hedge is approx 2.5 high so there would be a crown reduction down to 2.5 mtrs. No crown lift involved.

T17 and T18 would be a crown reduction by approx 3m and a crown thin of approx 20%.

T19 needs to go altogether due to it leaning over a lot. T20 and T21 need a 2 meter crown lift and about 2 meter crown reduction to get the branches away or out of telephone wires.
