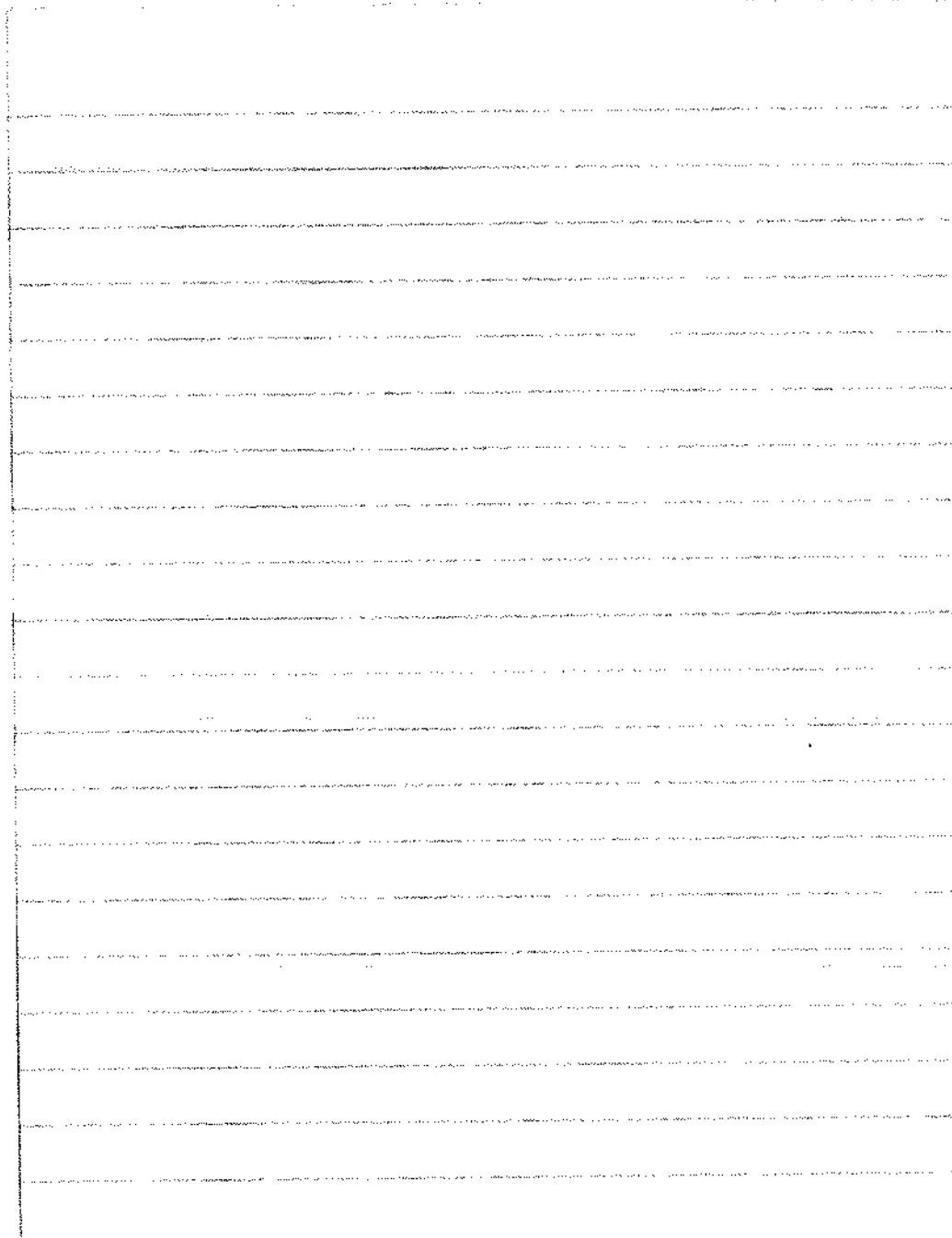

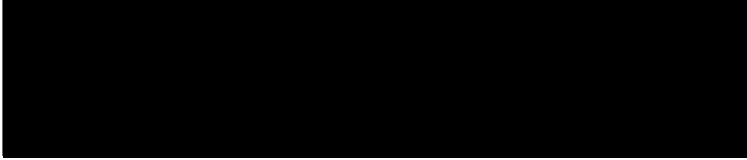

It is vitally important to both my own safety and the animals welfare that I am able to use my mobile phone. In the case of an emergency I would be unable to call for help or arrange an emergency referral while still being in attendance of a sick or injured animal. Equally it also makes it impossible for me

to be contactable by my office, partner vets or other clients should they have an emergency. Not having mobile phone signal is prohibitive to my business' activities.

I am fully in support of this appeal against the refusal of planning permission for the above proposal.
