Comments	<p>I strongly object to this planning application and the most recent amendments made to it on the basis of my previous comments still remaining valid. In particular this will place an unnecessary and burden on a very limited road infrastructure. In particular there there is prior history of goods vehicles and other commerical traffic ignoring routing guidance and attempting to traverse the village in order to get to Boddington. This will lead to increased damage to property in the village due to the increased risk from vehicles and increase the traffic flow through the village unnecessarily. This has been experienced on many occasions with vehicle transporters and other articulated vehicles that have got stuck in the village or grounded on the canal bridge as a result of incorrect satellite navigation software - a fact that the tranport plan fails to mention. Added to this will be the additional car traffic resulting in significant congestion both outside and through Claydon given our existing experience of people using Claydon as a "rat run" to get to Lower Boddington in preference to using the A423 . Similarly it is inconceivable to believe that the proposed site will be simply used as holiday moorings, which is admitted in the submitted transport plan, and will likely follow the pattern of usage seen in Cropredy Marina development where it was quickly established that there was an influx of permanent residents that placed additional burden upon the very limited capacity of the local infrastructure such as the doctors and local schools. Once again, I strongly object to this development application.</p>
