range. Entrance on left has plank door, moulded wood frame and wood lintel. Open, thatched porch. Ground floor has four C20 windows in original openings with wood lintels. To left, attic has a 2-light casement and a single-light stone framed window over porch. To right, three 2-light stone mullioned eyebrow dormers have hood moulds and label stops. Lead comes, wrought-iron casement fasteners and springs. Interior not inspected.
