I write to you in relation to the refusal of planning permission to complete the railings and letter we received on the 1st February 2018.

We live at number 10 Miller Close, so it's right outside our house where the railings have stopped being erected, yet the first we heard that planning permission had been refused was when we received a letter through our door stating that someone had appealed the refusal.

Just to be clear, we would like the railings to be completed, what I'm not happy about is that we were not made aware of the issues until the appeals window had close, meaning we can't appeal the refusal.

What's also not clear is what the suggested alternatives are from the council, are they planning on leaving it as is? Or take it down and replace with something else? We don't want it left, as it looks unfinished and makes the close looks untidy.

We are also aware that the reason why 100's of school children who attend the heyford school cut through Miller Close is due to there not being a railing, we have been told that the school tell them to stick to the main path, but this isn't happening, the railings will help stop this happening also.

Please can you advise us;

- A) If there is a way in which we can appeal the planning permission refusal
- B) What the suggested alternative is from the council
