9. ARCHAEOLOGY AND CULTURAL HERITAGE

9.1 INTRODUCTION

- 9.1.1 As described in ES SEI **Chapter 4**: Proposed Development and shown on **Figure 4.2b** Composite Parameter Plan, minor changes have been proposed in parcel 29 Core Visitor Destination Area and parcel 31 Educational Site with Potential Early Years Provision to accommodate amended requirements for the capacity and use of the school and associated facilities. The proposed maximum storey heights as shown on **Figure 4.3b** Building Heights remain unchanged within these parcels at 10.5m.
- 9.1.2 First, it is proposed to add a single-storey covered link along the south side of the open aircraft hangar 2004 of the Victor Alert area (which is intended for use as a covered play area), in association with a slight alteration to the 2-storey building zone as a result of a change in the capacity of the school.
- 9.1.3 Secondly, there is a minor boundary change between parcels 29 and 31, affecting the alignment of the NE boundary of parcel 31 and the SW boundary of parcel 29, in order to provide a rectilinear edge to the soft PE area and its 5m. perimeter clearance zone.

9.2 CONCLUSIONS

- 9.2.1 These proposed minor changes have been subject to review in accordance with the Cultural Heritage methodology and ES assessment criteria. The assessment of the hangar 2004 in the ES SEI dated March 2020 already took into account the impact of 'external alterations' [paras 9.4.28, 9.4.41, and 9.4.68] and it is concluded that the proposed minor changes from the proposed covered link and alteration to the 2-storey building zone would not materially alter the assessment and conclusions of the Cultural Heritage assessment [para 9.4.69, etc.], or the cumulative effects as described in the ES SEI dated March 2020.
- 9.2.2 In the case of the boundary changes these are of such a minor extent that they will in no way result in any change of effects for the Cultural Heritage as described in the ES SEI dated March 2020.
