As a supporter of footpaths and bridleways which provide a connection between the villages there should be more research done into the connections between Heyford park and the surrounding localities and the connections of the Heritage Trail are not clear. A footpath is a PROW so why is the footpath not labelled on the map where it has been marked before - please could the reason for this be clarified . TN305 Reassesment of Heyford park and Middleton Stoney Bus Gate. I object to the planning of the bus gate as it will only push the traffic congestion down the road to Somerton with its blind entrances ,narrow road , hump back bridge, little pavement for pedestrians and sid so extra money from S106 although welcome may not reduce the number of vehicles . Mitigation proposed in the traffic report is to be focused on "discouraging through traffic from using this route" but where will it be encouraged to go ? The survey surprisingly did not include the interconnecting Ardley Somerton rd and with the new Ardley junction the traffic will increase along this narrow old cart road to the M40? A34 . A reduced speed to 40 mph and weight restriction (not agric vehicles ) is very much needed . This is a massive planning application in a lovely area of Oxfordshire which will provide much needed employment and homes but it is a difficult time for discussion and research so I hope more time may be given to work on the important living points above .
