| Comments | <p>The proposal concerning re-routing traffic, preventing use of the B4030 from Middleton Stoney and directing it along the A4095 instead, is extremely impractical in my opinion for the following reasons: 1. The B4030 is far more suited to taking heavy traffic than the A4095 - there are no difficult bends along it, no villages to drive through after Middleton Stoney and no speed bumps. 2. The A4095, not only passes through a village but drivers would also have to negotiate a blind, 90 degree bend, a 30 mph speed limit and a speed bump. Just ask any HGV driver or police traffic officer which of the two roads they would recommend driving along, given the choice. The A prefix to 4095 is totally misleading. Please consider my objection.</p> |
