Dear Mr Lewis

I would like to object to the plan to move heavy traffic from the B4030 to the A4095. The A4095, which runs through Chesterton village, is particularly narrow when it comes through the village. There is scarce enough room for normal traffic, but large lorries would have to take the tight 90 degree bend, as you enter the village from the north, in the middle of the road, thus increasing the likelihood of accidents at this T junction.

The road is heavily used and a 43% increase in traffic is unacceptable. The houses fronting the road will suffer increased pollution and noise. There are a series of speed bumps on this road and a chicane with its own speed bump. This particular speed bump is particularly prone to damage which can then end up tearing up car tyres even when driving slowly, as I know to my financial detriment. Any increase in heavy traffic will increase wear and tear to the speed bump bringing additional costs to the council as well as road users.
