Following on from our letter below, I also wanted to add google map satellite images to show the difference between the Middleton Stone cross roads and the corner that HGVs will negotiate in Chesterton.

I would like to highlight also that an agricultural company uses this cross roads with enough space to manoeuvre their Combine Harvesters and trucks etc. They have been there for years without an issue. www.turneygroup.com for the list of equipment they get through the lists and round that corner. Which makes B4030 the easiest and straightest road for HGVs.

The Chesterton "Blind corner" by The Hale road. This road doesn't have room to swing out to make the corner otherwise they will go into oncoming traffic.

The traffic lights at the Middleton Stoney cross roads prevents on coming traffic so the HGVs can swing out to make the corner with enough space, if they need to.
