I attended the Parish Council meeting yesterday (16th July) and noted the residents of Wroxton comments regarding proposed use, traffic, parking, kitchen noise/odours and licensing. I believe that all were in agreement that owners, architects, contractors and villagers working together will ensure that the re-opened North Arms will be re-established as the considerable village asset it once was. The concerns of immediate neighbours can I am sure be addressed by the instillation of a state-of-the-art commercial kitchen and extractors, the opening of the college car park for North Arms patrons, and very careful consideration of licensing applications made by the North Arms management/owners.
