Comments	<input type="text" value="As a student at Wroxton College (Spring of 1968) I had a particular interest in the North Arms stables: it was there that I was allowed by the publican to store my motorcycle. That said, I think that the planning application, and in particular the conversion of the stables into a banquet facility that may make the entire venture commercially viable, is very much deserving of support. For one thing, the building is in danger of decay beyond hope of repair if this application is not approved. But perhaps most significantly, the revitalized North Arms will serve, as it did during the early years of Wroxton College, as an important community center where locals from the area can interact, over a pint and a quiz game, with the American students studying at Wroxton Abbey. These cross-cultural interactions were among the highlights of my semester abroad a half century ago. I am hopeful that with a refurbished and viable North Arms, such experiences, and the friendships stemming from them, can continue."/>
