Hope you are well.

The *Taxus baccata* seeds within the fruit are poisonous and therefore the location of these hedges adjacent to the nursery garden is inappropriate.

Many reported cases Ingestion of small quantities may result in mild poisoning. Ingestion of larger quantities may result in severe poisoning.

Refer to Poisonous Plants A guide for parents and childcare providers/Elizabeth A. Dauncey

I suggest *Escallonia* 'Apple Blossom' as a replacement (evergreen with pink flowers)
