









## **HERITAGE IMPACT ASSESSMENT**

The following text is an explanation of the significance of the existing staircase, this is taken from the supporting heritage impact assessment prepared by

Dr Rose Todd"

"The grouna-to-first floor section of the staircase seems to have been moved to accommodate the kitchen in the make-over of the 1980s. A small section of three treats and risers seems to have been re-used from an older staircase but the bulk of the existing staircase at ground floor level is commensurate with the reorganisation of the 1980s. The loss of this section of the existing stair can be considered a neutral intervention since no historic fabric of merit is to be lost." **Dr Rose Todd**


