Comments	<input type="text" value="This question has been asked before but no answer has been forth coming. The spine road across this whole development site from A361 to Bodicote Flyover was proposed by the Local Plan Inspector to form part of a link from the A361 to M40 via Bankside (part) and Chalker Way. Routing this road through the centre of a new housing development is not compatible with this function nor is it desirable in terms of the environment of the new estate. It appears that speed tables are to be provided at all the cross-road intersections and this again is not compatible with the intended function. The mere existance of the link road will result in it becoming used as a route to avoid congestion in Banbury centre, thereby improving the environment of the town centre, which it is beeived was the Inspector's intent. If the road on the route shown on the plan is used as predicted, what happens when the anticipated outcry from the new residents materialises ?"/>
