The timber building and its use as a welding and metal fabrication workshop has existed since at least February 1981 when it was part of the lease with Mr David Bricknell as sworn in his Statutory Declaration, with its existence and use confirmed by Mr Kevin Hardie's Statutory Declaration for at least the period 1990/91 - 2005 and by Mr Chris Murphy's Statutory Declaration for at least the same period. Photographic evidence is also provided as Exhibits to the Statutory Declarations showing the existence and location of the timber building over at least the sworn period.

The timber building has always been and remains today located outside of the land the subject of an Enforcement Notice in 2005, as shown on the Surveyor Plan provided with and sworn by Mr Daljit Bening's Statutory Declaration, with the Surveyor Plan confirmed as an accurate representation of the existing and former situation in Statutory Declarations provided by Messrs Bricknell, Hardie and Murphy.

The structure and its use have therefore been in existence for at least a 10-year period, on land that falls outside of any previous or ongoing enforcement action and, as such, is a structure and use that are lawfully established by the passage of time.
