Comments	<input type="text" value="Reasons for objection below: Risk to local wildlife including deer and bats, the latter of which are regularly seen on Hobby Road of an evening and the former often frequent the fields on which development is planned. Traffic considerations; additional access from Banbury Road will not be sufficient to prevent the buildup of traffic already on Longford Park phases 1 and 2, particularly during busy periods for Longford Park school. Roads are frequently crowded due to a shortage of off-road parking and would become more so if traffic flow from Oxford Road into the proposed site were to increase. The risk of collisions both between vehicles, and between vehicles and pedestrians; will rise significantly as a result. Sewer and drainage facilities are unsuitable for the existing homes on Longford Park phase 2 and frequently result in sewer blockages on Hobby Road. Existing sewer/drainage infrastructure would not have been appropriate in scope for the original application of 700 homes, much less the 850 now proposed."/>
