<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="I object to this planning application, there are still empty homes currently on the various phases of Longford park so an additional 850 are not needed. In addition the current road structure cannot support another extension of this size. The drainage infrastructure is such that many homes have regularly blocked toilets and it simply couldnt cope with any more being plumbed into it. The main Oxford road would not be safe with this level of traffic being released onto it, or turning off from it. The longford park roads itself could also not cope with this additional increase in traffic coming through it. Ive lived on a building site for 5 years since I purchased my home, I think its time we deserve a break from 5 years of constant building noise and dust etc and heavy lorry traffic . There is not sufficient infrastructure to support this level of additional homes, no shops etc. The local GP's cannot support this level of additional health needs."/>
