<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="I object to Songthrush Rd and Hobby Rd being used as access roads for the proposed development. These are quiet residential streets and not appropriate for the increased traffic. With 850 homes there is a potential for 1000+ cars possibly making several journeys per day. Currently the residents park on the street because there is not enough designated parking spaces and the road is often congested. This is a good thing because it slows down the traffic and makes it safer for children to play. The road is not straight, being deliberately constructed with bends and constrictions to slow traffic flow; in many places two cars cannot pass and one of them has to wait. In addition the route passes a primary school. Access to this proposed development was never planned through Longford Park and is not appropriate. Also the timing of the application and posting of the planning applications around the neighbourhood seems particularly cynical while we are in the middle of lock-down."/>
