Comments	<input type="text" value="I live at 34 Hobby Road - I object to the recent planning application to build 850 homes on the field at the bottom of Hobby Road. Hobby Road is not wide enough to take the increase of traffic; that will become a through road. We have a primary school at the other end of Hobby Road, which, if this planning goes ahead and the through road is used as an access to the 850 new dwelling - Will cause a great risk to fatalities to the children living in this road. I would propose you open up another road from the Oxford road as a separate entrance, this will then stop the risks for the children. Another consideration is the cars that are parked on the road outside of the houses? Where would these cars now park. The residents that already live in Hobby Road - Live here with content and do not have any neighbour hood issues regarding parking etc. I am also considering the Bin lorries that will go up and down; as well as a possible BUS route. When I bought my house 4 years ago; I was under no illusion that the fields would one day be build on. I did not though ever consider that Hobby Road would ever be considered as an access (through) road. This is a really bad idea; from a risk prospective and also from the conjestion this will cause. Longford Park has been advertised as a quiet subberb area. The houses in this area are not cheep - Opening up this through road will cause great anxiety and promote a bad reputation for Longford park. Longford park has been build here near Bodicote as an attractive place to live. I oppose and Object very highly and would like you to reconsider my suggestion of opening up the Oxford road, the other side of the 'Banbury Rugby Club'. This will look very pleasant and detach it from Hobby Road being opened up. You will then still be able to build your 850 new dwellings. Thank you"/>
