<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="Banbury Active Travel Supporters (BATS, part of Banbury Community Action Group) is a group of representing the interests of cyclists and pedestrians in Banbury, and by working for better air quality, we are indirectly representing the interests of the entire local population. We are working with Cherwell District Council on the production of a LCWIP for Banbury, which is due out to public consultation later this month. This planning application has come to our attention because the route between Longford Park and the town centre has been identified as in need of improvement and we expect it to feature in the LCWIP as a priority. It is not acceptable that a development of 825 homes should be allowed to go ahead without a continuous, high quality safe cycling route to the town centre to provide residents with a choice of sustainable travel options. In OCC's supplemental response dated 2 June, Mr Tim Peart sets the case out extremely well, and we wholeheartedly support what he is saying."/>
